(EXTRA) TRADE SHOW INSTALLER INFORMATION

Hourly wage rates are: straight time \$20.13, time and one half \$30.20, double time \$40.26, less \$1.00 per hour dues check-off. This is the Extra and 'C' rate of pay.

Extra workers may be needed to work at AAOS at Moscone Center in San Francisco, or at other Bay Area trade shows in February. It's possible that Extras could be needed as soon as Wednesday, Feb. 2, but **the most likely work days will be Friday, Feb. 3 and Monday, Feb. 6** for the setup, and **Friday, Feb. 10** for the teardown.

Call (415) 675-9707 -- Non-Installer or Extra recorded information message. Best time to check – usually 4:00 p.m. Monday – Friday. PLEASE DO NOT CALL THE OFFICE.

- QUALIFICATIONS:** This job is very physical: you must be able to lift very heavy objects, be able to climb ladders and **be on time!**
- JOB DESCRIPTION:** Installers set up and remove exhibits, displays, signage, carpets, pipe & drape, etc., for conventions and trade shows at hotels and convention centers in San Francisco, San Jose, San Mateo, Santa Clara, Oakland, Monterey and more.
- CITIZENSHIP ELIGIBILITY:** You must meet all requirements of the United States Government.
- REQUIREMENTS & ID:** You **MUST** be 18 years of age. You must have picture identification, your social security card, and at least one of the following when you sign in for work: valid California driver license, California ID, Passport, or U.S. Military Identification card. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**
- DISPATCH:** You may **ONLY BE DISPATCHED** to work by the Union Dispatcher. After phoning the (415) 675-9707 message tape and told that work is available for Extras, **you will be given a number to call** and talk to the Dispatcher. Write it down. Be sure to have a pen or pencil and paper handy to write down the information the Dispatcher gives you. **Do not call the Dispatcher until after you call the tape, listen to the message, and are told to call in.** Do not work without talking to the Union Dispatcher. The employer may call you back only for the continuation of a set-up or the dismantle of that show. If you are not told to come back for the dismantle immediately after set-up, you are eligible for another dispatch. An employer may **not** move you from one show site to another. You must call the Union if you are uncertain on any issues of dispatch because violations may result in penalties. You can be removed from the dispatch list.
- TELEPHONE:** It is mandatory that you can be reached by telephone 24 hours a day. You may have up to two numbers for that purpose.

Pay Day – Each employer pays weekly regardless of hours worked. You will not be paid at layoff – your paycheck will be mailed to you after the end of the weekly pay period.

Always save your check stubs and your time cards.

Be neat and clean - wear a shirt, pants and shoes -- no thongs or sandals. Take directions; do not argue with forepersons, installers or exhibitors. Exhibitors are usually visitors to our beautiful Bay Area. They are the customer. We want them to leave happy and come back.

Local 510 is not your employer. Your employer is the company you work for; please do not list Local 510 as your employer for unemployment, state disability, credit applications, job references, etc. State that **you are an applicant** of Local 510. We verify membership for members. You are not a member yet!

Important: by accepting a dispatch from Local 510 you are committed to show up. If you can’t, notify the Employer you were assigned to. A list of Employers and attendance reporting numbers is on the Local 510 website – www.local510.org
